Supporting the Six Major Goals of *Achieve 2015*

As considered by the Local Advisory Board, May 20, 2010

**GOAL: ACCESS**

- 1. Increase Overall Enrollment, Dual Enrollment, and Enrollment from Underserved Populations**  
Increase enrollment in all these categories by 3% over 2009-10.
- 2. Educational Programs**  
Develop 2 new career studies certificate, certificate or degree programs that respond to emerging, critical workforce needs.
- 3. Increase Enrollment in Community Colleges by Students Served by Career Coaches**  
Increase the percentage of high school graduates from high schools served by a career coach who, within one year of graduation, enroll in a community college, as compared with 2009-10.

**GOAL: AFFORDABILITY**

- 4. Increase Financial Aid Applicants and Recipients**  
Increase the number of students who receive financial aid and scholarships by 10% over 2009-10.

**GOAL: STUDENT SUCCESS**

- 5. Increase Career/Technical Awards**  
Increase the number of career and technical education awards by 1.5% overall and by 3% for underserved students.
- 6. Increase Career Readiness Certificates**  
Increase the number of Career Readiness Certificates awarded by 3% over 2009-10.
- 7. Redesign Developmental Education**  
Implement appropriate recommendations of the Developmental Mathematics Redesign Team and the Developmental English Redesign Team in accordance with the Developmental Education Initiative Grant and Re-engineering efforts.

**GOAL: WORKFORCE**

- 8. Serve Employers through College Courses and Programs**  
Increase the number of employers served through college credit and noncredit courses, customized training, and other outreach efforts by 5%.
