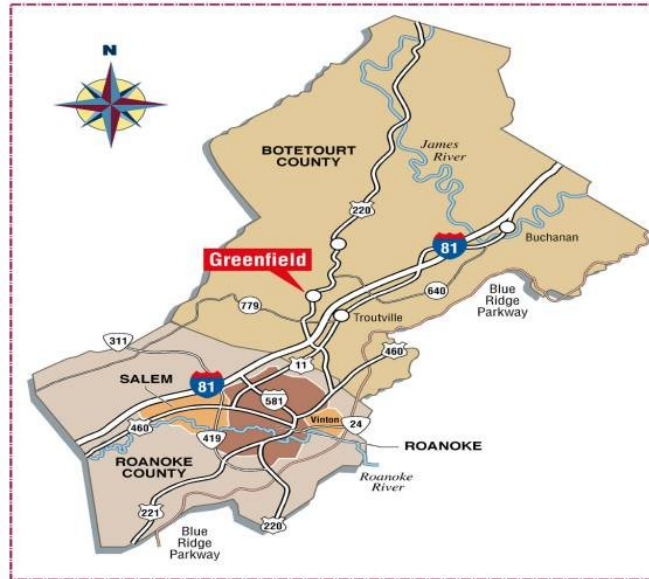

## *Backflow Prevention Device Certification Training Program*

- The Commonwealth of Virginia requires individuals engaged in maintenance, repair and testing, or periodic inspection of cross connection devices be certified in backflow prevention.
- Virginia Western Community College offers classes approved by the Department of Professional and Occupational Regulation (DPOR) that meet the training requirements for certification. Individuals with less than 7 years work experience are required to take a minimum of 40 hours of training to become certified.
- Individuals with 7 or more years of work experience are required to complete a 16-hour training class. Refresher classes may assist professionals in meeting continuing education requirements. Virginia Western also offers the 16-hour review program. Classes are generally offered at least once each semester.
