Classify as Spam	Classifies the selected message as spam.

Definitions of whitelist and blacklist:

List Type	Description
Whitelist	The list of email addresses or domains from which you always wish to receive messages. The only time the Barracuda Spam Firewall blocks a message from someone on your whitelist is when the message contains a virus or a disallowed file extension.
Blacklist	The list of senders from whom you never want to receive messages. The Barracuda Spam Firewall immediately discards messages from users on your blacklist. These messages are not tagged or quarantined and cannot be recovered. The sender does not receive a notice that the message was deleted, and neither do you. The only time a blacklisted email address is delivered is if the same email address also appears in your whitelist.

Note: Email is intercepted by the Barracuda Spam Firewall before it reaches the email server, so the whitelist and blacklist entries for the Barracuda are different from the junk email whitelist and blacklist in Outlook.
