



If you are interested in applying to the VWCC LPN to Nursing AAS Bridge Program, you **MUST** complete the college application to Virginia Western as well as the 2027 Nursing AAS Bridge Program application. The college application must be submitted on-line, but your program application must be completed and sent to Pam Woody in the Health Professions office

via mail or submit attached application to [healthprofessions@viriniawestern.edu](mailto:healthprofessions@viriniawestern.edu).

You are encouraged to complete the VWCC college application on-line by logging into the system at <https://apply.vccs.edu>



Indicate Virginia Western Community College as the college you plan to attend and your plan of study as **CSC: Introduction to Nursing**. Choose the earliest semester or term you may be likely to register for any class at VWCC or no later than spring 2027. High school seniors should select the fall semester (2026). If upon completion of HS you wish to take a summer course and encounter problems registering, you should seek assistance from the college enrollment center in Chapman Hall. If any applicant encounters difficulty submitting your information electronically, further assistance may be available in Chapman Hall for students.

**NOTE:** if applicants have graduated in an Intro to Health Professions plan, they cannot select the Intro to Nursing and will need to plan to self-pay for the courses as only one Intro to Health Professions CSC can be completed. Please see your Program Advisor for more information.
