

**Paramedic Program at CVCC**  
**Joint Venture with Central Virginia Community College and**  
**Virginia Western Community College For Fall 2026**

The following is intended as a general guideline for making sure you have taken the necessary steps to apply and be considered for the Joint Venture CVCC Paramedic program. **It is the applicant's responsibility to ensure that all items arrive to CVCC as indicated. Late application materials may not be considered and may make the applicant ineligible to be considered for the 2026 program.** Please understand an applicant may have unique circumstances, which may require further documentation or verification, in which case the applicant may be asked to furnish material not mentioned below. Every effort will be made to provide clear instructions to applicants needing to provide such information. Please keep this checklist to refer to – you do NOT need to return it to us. **Please remember to read and submit all required admission items/documents to the Health Professions Advising and Applications Office at VWCC and submit the Paramedic application to CVCC directly. Follow the directions listed in this checklist (in the order listed to avoid confusion.)** When requested by CVCC (prior to your meeting with Program Specialist at CVCC), your file, with the required information you have submitted to VWCC will be shared with CVCC.

*Please note CVCC will determine acceptance into their program (Joint Venture with VWCC) and Financial Aid will be administered through the CVCC Financial Aid Office and any documents related to Financial Aid will need to be submitted to CVCC's Financial Aid Office. If accepted into the program and upon completion of the program, your degree will be awarded from Central Virginia Community College.*

- VWCC college application – Must be completed **on-line**. (If you currently attend VWCC – you may skip this step.) **To facilitate actions taken** in the computer system by your advisor and other staff at VWCC please select **Career Studies Certificate: Introduction to Paramedic** as your **curricular plan of study (credit classes)** and we suggest activating the term for Summer 2026 (if available or choose the latest term closest to summer) or even **sooner** if you plan to take any general class at VWCC before then (the actual Paramedic classes will not begin until fall semester for those accepted).
  
- Applicants **must also apply to** Central Virginia Community College (on-line). VWCC students must complete **both college applications**: VWCC and CVCC to be considered complete-as some classes will be completed/registered for at CVCC and some classes will be registered for at VWCC.

**Please select the following program/plan at CVCC: Emergency Medical Services, Paramedic, AAS. - Official High School transcripts, in the sealed school envelope from the High School, if mailing. (Required for all applicants, including those with college courses and/or degree. Send to VWCC Health Professions Advising and Applications Office.) If your High School utilizes an electronic portal, such as Parchment, please submit to VWCC -Allied Health. If the High School utilize electronic portal, such as Scribbles or National Clearinghouse, please submit to [pwoody@virginiawestern.edu](mailto:pwoody@virginiawestern.edu) or [healthprofessions@virginiawestern.edu](mailto:healthprofessions@virginiawestern.edu).

- GED-copy of scores (*if applicable*). Please submit to Health Professions Advising and Applications Office at VWCC.
  
- Official college transcripts from colleges where you may have completed any support class(es) from a regionally accredited Institution (except community colleges in Virginia). Note: Official transcripts are still in the original sealed envelope from the institution that issued it, please **do not open them (if sent or given to you first)**. If you attend fall or spring classes at a non-VCCS school you must have updated transcripts sent to the VWCC Health Professions Advising and Applications Office. These transcripts serve to update your GPA, academic progress, and completion or enrollment in General Education courses.
- Be aware of Essential Functions of the program—can be discussed with the Program Director at CVCC
- Be aware of cost associated with the program that Financial Aid may not cover (physical, uniforms, etc.)
- Be prepared to provide own transportation to Greenfield and clinical sites
- Be prepared to complete BIO 141 by end of summer 2026 and BIO 142 by end of fall 2026 or complete BIO 145 (at CVCC) by end of fall 2026. Note: prerequisites for the BIO 141, at VWCC, exist. Please see an advisor for assistance.

- Please be aware of the following prerequisites for consideration for the program at CVCC:

-Must be **18 years of age by first day of class**

-Must be a High School graduate one month prior to first day of class and submit official final High School transcript or complete the GED at least one month prior to the first day of class and provide scores.

-**Must have** and submit the following (in pdf format) to the following link at VWCC ([Health Professions Document Upload](#)):

(1) **current American Heart Association -BLS, Adult, Child and Infant with AED CPR** card <https://www.vdh.virginia.gov/emergency-medical-services/education-certification/student-resources/cpr-requirements/> (HLT 105, at VWCC, will satisfy the requirement, and you will be sent the card for submission to your application file at VWCC.) Please submit a current AHA-BLS card to the Health Professions Advising and Applications Office. Must remain current for duration of the program.

(2)-**a current Virginia EMT or higher certification**. Submit copy of current card to Health Professions Advising and Applications Office at VWCC. (Must remain current for duration of program.)

(3)-**a color copy of your current driver's license** to the Health Professions Advising and Applications Office. (color copy required)

-Must not have been convicted of any disqualifying crime as mandated by Virginia Office of EMS. <https://law.lis.virginia.gov/admincode/title12/agency5/chapter31/section910/> If yes, please contact the Program Director, Mr. Joey Greer ([GreerJ@centralvirginia.edu](mailto:GreerJ@centralvirginia.edu)) at CVCC.

(remember if interested in Financial Aid, this is administered through the Financial Aid Office at CVCC)

-apply to the Paramedic Program (link to application will be forthcoming)

Be prepared **to submit** the following to the Health Professions Advising and Applications Office at VWCC prior to application deadline:

-submit official High School final transcript or copy of GED scores  
--official transcripts of college courses attempted (outside of the Virginia Community College System)

-submit copy of the following

- \*AHA-BLS CPR card (current)—must remain current for duration of program
- \*Current Virginia EMT or higher certificate
- \*color copy (required) of current driver's license

New students to VWCC are encouraged to meet with New Student Advisors for assistance in beginning coursework at VWCC. Current VWCC students can meet with Program Advisor, Ms. Rhonda Perdue.

Upon submission of **all** application materials to VWCC, including the Paramedic application to CVCC (link will be forthcoming) notify the VWCC Health Professions Advising and Applications Office of your interest in meeting with the advisor at CVCC, so information submitted can be relayed to CVCC.

**Note the application deadline is July 15 and applicants are notified by CVCC by August 1.**

Later applications may be accepted if the class is not filled. However, early application and submission of materials are strongly encouraged.

- Meet with a program representative for review of you application. The meeting can be in person or virtual, depending on the students' needs. There will be additional information and required items that a program representative will discuss with applicants such as:

- ALS EMS Program Student Information
- Electronic FERPA Consent
- Sign a Waiver of Liability
- Student Clinical Badge Form
- Order Uniform(s) (wait for meeting with Amy for details)
- Photo Release Form
- Questionnaire
- Clinical Packet (outlines policy, procedures, required vaccinations, required medical form to

be completed by MD, PA, NP, RN or LPN) and includes such information as PPD, TB, Flu vaccine, Health Record, Immunization and Vaccinations, Copy of Shot Record, etc.

- In addition, Credit for Prior Learning such as RN license, Intermediate certification, AEMT and etc. may receive credit for prior learning when presenting a valid Virginia license to Program Advisor, Anything other than CPR, EMT or AEMT should be referred to the program director located at CVCC (i.e. RN or Intermediate)

Be prepared for fingerprinting after the first day of class.
