# How do I apply?

Who is eligible to apply for TRIO?

You must meet <u>at least one</u> (1) of the following:

- A First-Generation College Student: Neither parent/guardian has a Bachelor's degree from an accredited institution
- Meet Low-Income Guidelines: Generally, if you are receiving PELL grant aid, you will qualify
- Have A Disability: Physical, psychological, or learning

#### AND BOTH of the following:

- » Enrolled in classes at Virginia Western Community College
- » A U.S. Citizen, or intend to become a citizen

#### How do I apply?

- 1. Complete a TRIO Pathways application (scan code below)
- 2. Meet with a TRIO Coach, call 540-857-7289 to schedule an appointment
