Virginia Western Community College Associate in Applied Science, Criminal Justice  
Bachelor of Science in Criminal Justice Radford University Degree Program**

This agreement is designed for students who plan to graduate with an Associate in Applied Science degree in Administration of Justice and transfer to the Radford University Bachelor of Science degree program in Criminal Justice at the Roanoke Higher Education Center. **NB:**

A letter grade of C or higher must be earned in all CRJU prefix courses in order to graduate with a degree in Criminal Justice.

No fewer than 45 semester hours must be earned at Radford University to be eligible for graduation. In addition, 50 percent of the semester hours required for a major or minor (as defined by the department) must be taken at Radford University and no more than six (6) credit hours of Independent Study coursework can be used toward graduation requirements.
