Applicants must complete the following **prerequisites** with a grade of "C" or better **by the end of Spring 2025**: college-level **ENG 111** College Composition I, and **SDV 101** Orientation to Health Professions-two credits. **MGCC applicants (for SDV prerequisite)** : must complete SDV 101-one credit and either HLT 100-two credits or HLT 143-three credits to be able to use the HLT course credits for the second credit of SDV requirement. The cumulative GPA must be ≥ 2.0 by the end of the spring 2025 semester to be eligible for the fall 2025 program. **Please note for both VWCC and MGCC**: A recent college level Biology with final grade of "C" or higher or NAS 2 with final grade of "S" is a prerequisite for VWCC's BIO 252 (Nucleic Acid Methods) or BIO 141 Anatomy and Physiology I & completing MDE 10 or Direct Enrollment into college level math is a prerequisite for CHM 101(and BIO 101/NAS 2 at VW). CHM 101 is included in the fall semester for MLT. BIO 252/BIO 141 must be completed within the last 5 years prior to entering the program. We encourage early application and submission of official transcripts to the Health Professions office for course mapping.
