The cumulative GPA must be > 2.0 by the end of the fall 2021 semester to be eligible for the 2022 program.

Please note – A recent college level Biology or NAS 2 with final grade of "C or higher is a prerequisite for VWCC's BIO 252 (Nucleic Acid Methods) and completing Math Units 1-5 or equivalent is a prerequisite for CHM 101. Both classes (BIO 252 & CHM 101) are included in the fall semester. BIO 252 must be completed within the 5 years prior to entering the program. We encourage early application and submission of official transcripts to the Health Professions office for course mapping.
