Virginia Western Community College's dual enrollment (DE) program is committed to providing high school aged students with the opportunity to complete college-level classes at their local high schools or on the Virginia Western campus, while satisfying the requirements for the completion of their junior and senior high school courses. Students should work with an Academic Advisor to determine appropriate Plans of Study for degree or transfer opportunities.

Enrollment and tuition for dual enrollment courses that are taught at the high school is processed through the high school guidance department. Tuition for courses taught by Virginia Western faculty through distance learning or on campus require the standard tuition payable by the student to the college. Students enroll through the college's Enrollment Center. Dual Enrollment students are not eligible for federal or state financial aid.

High School students may have the opportunity to earn the *GOVERNOR'S SCHOLAR Medallion* if they complete an Associate's degree or the Uniform Certificate of General Studies concurrent with high school graduation. Students should contact their high school guidance department for further information.

Students seeking one of Virginia Western's A.A.S. degrees or a Career Studies Certificate (CSC) may apply for program placement. These degrees or certificates do not earn the Medallion but represent exceptional commitment to excellence by the student.

Dual Enrollment students must meet the admission requirements for the college. Students must have a 3.0 HS GPA to participate in any transfer program. Prior to participating in this program, students need to complete a Virginia Western Application for Admission and Application for Virginia Domicile for students requesting in-state tuition. Students will need to submit a copy of their current High School Transcript.
