BOARD MINUTES #72

The Virginia Western Community College Board met Monday, September 20, 1976, 12 p.m., at the Hotel Roanoke.

Mr. Vinyard introduced Mr. Maury L. Strauss, new Board member from the City of Roanoke.

Mr. Vinyard asked for the approval of the April 5, 1976 Board minutes. Mr. Dalhouse moved that the reading of the minutes be dispensed with, which motion was seconded and carried.

Dr. Hopper introduced Dr. Houston and Mr. Starnes of the Office of Institutional Research: Dr. Houston related that the function of that office is to supply relevant and factual data that can assist the college's decision-makers in the areas of institutional reporting, administrative data needs, evaluation studies and community college research library. Mr. Starnes reported on the status of June 1976 graduates, those employed and those choosing to further their education. Dr. Hopper and Dr. Houston gave a brief history of enrollment and curricular changes that have taken place over a 10 year period.

Dr. Hopper introduced Mr. Dwight Blalock, Dean of Financial and Administrative Services: Mr. Blalock distributed to the Board information and discussion material relative to the local budget fund report, bookstore fund income statement, and report of parking availability. Mr. Blalock presented for the Board's approval three projects:

Project 1 - paving 100 space lot adjacent to the Fine Arts Building and a 15 space lot behind Brown Library for the handicapped for a total cost of \$10,000.

Project 2 - installation of plumbing for restrooms and showers in the Physical Education Building, above the tennis courts, at a cost of \$10,000.

Project 3 - installation of lighting at the six tennis courts at a cost of \$33,000.

Total cost of the three projects: \$53,000.

After some discussion, Mr. Dalhouse moved that funds be appropriated for the two parking lots in Project 1 and improvements to the Physical Education Building in Project 2. Mr. Hamilton seconded and the motion carried.

Dr. Hopper informed the Board that the Annual State Board meeting would be held in Williamsburg on October 28, 29 and 30. Mr. Dalhouse suggested electing a contingent of the Board to represent our Local Board and pay for the trip from local funds. Mr. Thomas moved that the Chairman, Vice Chairman and President represent VWCC Local Board, paying from local funds. Mrs. Utecht second, and the motion carried. It was agreed, however, that other Board members wishing to go to the meeting would pay their own expenses.

Dr. Hopper informed the Board of the Governor's 5% budget cut.

Dr. Hopper reminded the Board of the 10 Year Celebration to be held on September 30 and verbally issued an invitation for the Board to attend.

Dr. Hopper also mentioned Mr. Ralph Nader's visit to the Roanoke Civic Center, sponsored by VWCC, on October 18 at 8 p.m. and invited the Board to attend.

Dr. Hopper informed the Board of VWCC's plans for weekend college classes in conjunction with Radford College and the opportunity of providing a baccalaureate to citizens of the Roanoke Valley.

For the Board's information, Dr. Hopper mentioned VWCC's policy regarding the review of controversial learning resources center materials by a committee of faculty who would deal with any complaints.

Mr. Jennings moved that the President's Discretionary Fund account balance be restored to \$200 by authorizing an additional amount of \$345.03. Mrs. Painter seconded, and the motion carried.

The next Board meeting will take place at Virginia Western Community College, at 2 p.m., Fishburn Hall Conference Room, on November 1, 1976.

There being no further business, the meeting adjourned at 2:20 p.m.
