# BOARD MINUTES #77

The Virginia Western Community College Board met Friday, April 7, 1978, at 2:30 p.m., in the Fishburn Hall Conference Room.

Dr. Hopper introduced Dr. Charles Houston, Director of Institutional Research, who summarized Fall to Winter erroliment trends from 1973 - 1978. Dr. Houston said that:

- 1. The rate of percent withdrawal of 1977-78 Fall to Winter headcount stopouts decreased in comparison to 1975-77 stopouts; however, the rate of percent decrease of 1977-78 Fill corollment increased in comparison to 1976-77. Inolications: nove headcounts are needed to produce FTE enrollments.
- 2. Fall to Winter stopouts by race indicated no significant trends.
- 3. Fall to Winter stopouts by student status indicate that parttime night students are most likely to withdraw.
- 4. Fall to Winter stopouts tend to be students who are not classified as Veterans and/or Veteran Dependents. A definite trend toward fewer Veteran and/or Veteran Dependent enrollments was noted.
- 5. VMCC continues to enroll large numbers of new and transfer students for both Fall and Winter Quarters. In examining returning students for Winter 1978, it should be noted that there were 1,583 students enrolled Fall 1977 who did not return Winter 1978.
- 6. A decrease in average credit hours per headcount was discerned with major decreases in average credit hours pur headcount for part-time night and nts.

Dr. Hopper indicated that this does have implications for future enrollment at Virginia Western and all college faculty and Board members should be concerned about enrollment trends. BOARD MINUTES **#77**
