Guidelines and Requirements for the Scholarship

- Complete and submit this "Scholarship Application" to the VWCC Dual Enrollment Office by March 31.
- Attach a one-page essay to the application, using the prompt: ***A career in a health-related area is important to me because... (1 – 2 page limit, typed, double spaced)***
- Maintain a 3.0 GPA in the Academy classes. Students who fall below the 3.0 GPA in Fall classes may not be eligible for scholarship assistance for the spring term
- Students who drop or withdraw from an Academy class, and a scholarship has been awarded for that class, will be required to refund the money paid by the scholarship
- Scholarship funds may not be used to re-take a class
- At the end of the program, students may be asked to write a summary about their experience and how the scholarship aided the student with meeting their career or academic goals. The essay may be submitted to the Claude Moore Charitable Foundation, which may choose to publish student comments in marketing materials.
