



If you are interested in applying to the Nursing program at VWCC, you **MUST** complete the VWCC college application, as well as the program application form (other required material is discussed on the “Apply Now” page). The college application can be submitted on-line. The program application must be submitted using the on-line application (all material required by March 1st). **Note:** if applying for a future program, for example, Fall 2027, please complete the fall 2026 application and we can then move your information to fall 2027 during the application process, when you notify us of your desired application year.

You are encouraged to complete the VWCC college application on-line by logging into the system at <https://apply.vccs.edu>



Indicate Virginia Western Community College as the college you plan to attend and your plan of study as CSC: Introduction to Nursing. Choose the earliest semester or term you may be likely to register for any class at VWCC or no later than spring 2026. High school seniors should select the fall semester (2026). If upon completion of HS you wish to take a summer course and encounter problems registering, you should seek assistance from the college enrollment center in Chapman Hall. If any applicant encounters difficulty submitting your information electronically, further assistance may be available in Chapman Hall for students.
