

If you are planning to apply to VWCC's Radiation Oncology program at Virginia Western, you must complete the general VWCC college application on-line), as well as the program application form by March 15<sup>th</sup> (other required material is discussed on the "Apply Now" page). This is also required for those interested in the Joint Venture site at NVCC. All applicants are encouraged to complete now, but no later than the deadline. Those applying for the Northern Virginia Community College site will also need to complete a college application for NVCC before March 15 (unless you are already registered as a student there).

Select Virginia Western Community College as the college you plan to attend and your plan of study as <u>Career Studies Certificate</u>: <u>Introduction to Radiation Oncology</u>. Term activate the earliest semester you may be likely to register for any class at VWCC (if you would only be attending VWCC **if** you get into the program, choose the latest option closest to fall 2025).
