Applicants must meet the general admission requirements for the college. Students must have completed 1 unit of the following high school prerequisite: **one lab science** (*Biology preferred*). A deficiency in a HS science course may be satisfied by completing one semester of an equivalent or higher-level college course. Applicants must also **complete** the college level prerequisites of **BIO 141** (Human Anatomy & Physiology I-within five years prior) and **SDV 101** (Orientation for Health Professions-2 cr). All **prerequisites** must be completed **with a "C" or better**. **Missing prerequisite(s)** must be **completed by the end of Spring 2026** to be considered for fall 2026. The applicant's cumulative GPA must be **2.50** or higher by the end of Fall 2025 to be eligible for the fall 2026 program (based on 12 credit hours of college credit (non-developmental courses) from one Institution). BIO 141 cannot be used to fulfill both the lab science prerequisite and the BIO 141 prerequisite. These must be different courses. In addition, to be ready for the Physics portion of the Radiography program, if accepted, please complete the math skill survey located on the RAD checklist and follow through with any suggested training. Applicants must be at least 18 years of age by September 1 of the first semester of the program.
