



How to apply for Virginia Western Educational Foundation CCAP Scholarship in Scholarship Universe

TO APPLY FOR THE EDUCATIONAL FOUNDATION CCAP SCHOLARSHIP

Step 1

Go to <https://www.virginiawestern.edu/scholarships/>. Click APPLY button to access log-on screen.

Log into the Educational Foundation CCAP scholarship application at Scholarship Universe using your Virginia Western credentials (same as logging onto MyVWCC).
