Students must have completed the following college **prerequisites** with a "C" or better in each course: College level **Bio 141** (Human Anatomy & Physiology I) is a **prerequisite** requirement which must be completed with a grade of "C" or better. BIO 141 (4 cr. with lab) must be completed within five (5) years prior to entering program. **HLT 141& SDV 101** (2 cr.) are college **prerequisites**. Enrollment and completion of all **prerequisite(s) must be completed by the end of the summer prior to the fall semester when you are entering/starting the program (summer 2023 for fall 2023).** Cumulative college **GPA must be 2.50** or higher by the end of Spring 2023 to be eligible (based on at least 12 credit hours) or High School GPA will be used if applicant does not have 12 credit hours of college credit to establish the GPA. Please note: At VWCC the prerequisite for enrollment in BIO 141 is either challenge placement into BIO 141 or completion within the last three (3) years of BIO 101 with a grade of "C" or higher. Or, NAS 2 with a grade of "S". At VWCC the prerequisite for BIO 101/ NAS 2 is ENG 111 placement and Math units 1-5 or MDE 10.
