BRC BASIC RIDER COURSE

Students must be able to ride a bicycle. Maximum enrollment is 12 people per session.

This course teaches basic physical and mental skills used in everyday riding. Students learn basic skills of motorcycle operation, which includes turning, shifting, stopping, and straight-line riding. This course develops skills and street strategies necessary for safe and enjoyable motorcycle operation.

Upon successful completion of this class, eligible participants will receive a VA DMV completion certificate, which they will turn into the DMV exempting them from both the knowledge and the road skills exams. The certificate is valid for a period of 1 year from the date of course completion. The cost of this credit course is \$170.09 for in-state tuition and \$370.19 for out-of-state tuition. RVH classes are NOT eligible for financial aid or auditing.

Attendance:

All classes meet in the Business Science building, Room 245 on Friday from 6:00 - 9:30 p.m. and Saturday & Sunday from 8:00 a.m. to 5 p.m. on the Motorcycle Range unless otherwise stated below. Class could end earlier at the discretion of the instructor if all competencies for the instructional period are adequately covered, completed. STUDENTS MUST BE ON TIME FOR ALL SESSIONS. INSTRUCTORS DO NOT ADMIT LATE ARRIVALS.

Equipment & Dress Requirements:

This basic rider course provides motorcycles. Students are required to wear protective clothing: over the ankle shoes, sturdy full-finger gloves, long sleeve shirt or jacket, long pants, eye protection and **students must provide their own ¾ or full helmet (Dept. of Transportation approved),**
