Scroll to the bottom and click SAVE APPLICATION if you need to step away and continue the application at another time. When you come back and finish the application, click SUBMIT APPLICATION. You may not make edits to your application once it is submitted.

2) Answer all required questions (marked with \*).

3) Express yourself in the Personal Statements, This is your time to shine! The Personal Statements require short answers – but make sure you reply with the minimum 500 characters required, or your application will not be considered.

4) Upload a PDF of your most recent unofficial Virginia Western or other college transcript (high school transcript, if no college).

**5)** Submit names and email addresses for <u>three</u> people willing to provide a reference for your application. If you are a student currently at Virginia Western, one reference must be from a Virginia Western instructor or academic advisor.

## Instructions for Requesting References

**References** are one of the most important elements of any scholarship application as they can provide important insight about your abilities and commitment to learning.

This application requires you to **identify three people** who could provide you with a reference. This might be a supervisor or colleague at work, a former teacher or a leader in an organization (community, sports or religious) where you have been active. Be sure you ask them if they are willing to provide a reference for you before including them on your application.

If you attend Virginia Western, at least one of your references **must come from one of your instructors or an academic advisor** at the College. **References should not come from relatives or friends.** 

You will request these references by entering the email addresses of your individuals in the three boxes below. Reference providers will score you on things such as academic effort,

integrity and work ethic. Your references may also type a narrative in the textbox provided or upload a Letter of Reference if they wish.
