Virginia Western is close to home, affordable and provides high-quality academic and workforce career pathways. The Virginia Western Educational Foundation is a 501(c)(3) nonprofit organization sharing hope, opportunity and access through a culture of innovative support and philanthropy.

Our flagship scholarship program

Virginia Western's Community College Access Program (CCAP) started in 2008 as one of the Commonwealth's first "free college" programs and is nationally recognized for its unique 50-50% private-public funding model. CCAP provides tuition assistance for immediate high school graduates who meet program requirements, as funding allows. Students may also have the opportunity to receive tuition for workforce VIRGINIA WESTERN'S COMMUNITY COLLEGE ACCESS PROGRAM (CCAP)

credentials. CCAP reaches the entire Virginia Western Community College service region, and as part of giving back to the communities investing in their future, students volunteer hours of community service.

In 2023, CCAP is celebrating 15 years of service, \$10 million in tuition assistance, 4,000 participants and 30,000 hours of nonprofit volunteerism.

And the program is exponentially growing. CCAP saw its largest application pool ever in 2023, even after welcoming its largest cohort ever in 2022. What have we learned in our 15 years? That keeping the promise of CCAP translates to real-world success: **CCAP students boast a 91% average success rate.** This is a milestone worth celebrating.

VIRGINIA WESTERN RAPIDS RESPONSE STUDENT EMERGENCY FUND

The need is greater than you think.

These funds support students in crisis — those facing dire employment, housing, transportation, food, medical or technology needs. Requests are reviewed by cross-campus teams, and response time occurs in as little as 24-48 hours. Students are also connected to community resources for long-term assistance.

Before the pandemic, we served 2-3 students in need per semester. More than 180 students have needed and received critical support since March 2020.

- 96% of our students must work.
- 43% are first in their family to attend college.
- 25% have no family financial support systems.
- 15% need laptops or internet support to study.
- 10% are unsure of where they will sleep tonight.
