Al Pollard Memorial Scholarship for Culinary Arts	Provides assistance to first-year and continuing students for tuition, books and other related expenses. No minimum GPA is required to apply. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be enrolled in the Culinary Arts associate degree program. Applicants must detail their commitment to the culinary arts profession, commenting on any previous culinary arts experience and their future goals in the field.	\$ 2,000.00
Archibald Carter (Chip) Magee Memorial Annual Scholarship for Paralegal Studies	Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in a paralegal program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicants must indicate intent to pursue continuing higher education pathways for attainment of enrollment in law school. Priority will be given to students demonstrating financial need. Students may receive consecutive awards without application per continued eligibility.	\$ 2,375.00
Barry L. Pendrey Memorial Scholarship	Provides assistance to students enrolled in the Criminal Justice Program, with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicants must have completed 24 credit hours and have a letter of recommendation from a Criminal Justice faculty member. Applicants must detail their interest in a career in Criminal Justice in the personal statement section on the scholarship application.	\$ 750.00
Beverly and Leon Harris Teaching and Nursing Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA who intends to pursue a career in teaching or who is pursuing a degree in Nursing or a certificate in Practical Nursing. Priority is given to students demonstrating financial need.	\$ 780.00
Connie Stephens May Scholarship	Provides educational scholarship assistance to non-traditional students. Applicant must be high school graduate or equivalent for at least 3 years, a Roanoke Valley resident currently enrolled or enrolling in a two-year degree program at Virginia Western Community College. Applicant must demonstrate academic achievement with a minimum GPA of 2.5 and must demonstrate financial need.	\$ 887.00
Construction Management Certificate Program Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees to applicants who have high school degree or GED, are enrolled in at least two credits per semester in the Construction Management Career Studies Certificate Program and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Recipient must purchase course materials through the Virginia Western Campus Bookstore. Recipients must indicate their intent to work primarily in residential construction in the personal statement section on the scholarship application.	Varies
Delta Dental of Virginia Foundation Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees (including national and clinical examination fees) to a student with a minimum 3.5 GPA pursuing an Associate of Applied Science in the Dental Hygiene program. Before applying, applicants must have been accepted into Virginia Western's dental hygiene program.	\$ 930.00
Dolores Martin Skelly Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in an Associate of Science program in Science: Integrated Environmental Studies or in Science: Mathematics. Students must be graduates of Patrick Henry or William Fleming high schools in the city of Roanoke. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.	\$ 800.00
Dr. George K. Bowers Youth Haven Sanctuary Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and related expenses to students who demonstrate financial need and who: have finished or attended Youth Haven or Sanctuary; attended counseling with the Roanoke Juvenile Services and are recommended by the Youth Care Administrator; have been recommended by the courts/probation departments of Roanoke City, Roanoke County and Salem; are before the court on petition, or youth who are before Juvenile Intake; are enrolled in the Criminal Justice program.	\$ 2,500.00

Employee Giving Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other expenses to students entering their second year with the desire to complete their associate degree. The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.	\$ 1,000.00

Gerald Pace Textbook Scholarship for Salem CCAP Students	Provides assistance to a Salem CCAP student starting their second year of Salem CCAP. Student must be enrolled in a minimum 9 credits for the semester, have cumulative 3.0 GPA or better, and receive no federal or state financial aid.	\$ 1,000.00
J. David and Mary Ann Wine Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition and related fees for a student enrolled in Intro to Nursing, Nursing or Science: Health Science who intends to transfer to the University of Virginia Bachelor of Science in Nursing (UVa BSN) program. Applicant must submit the FAFSA for the applicable year. Recipient must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and may be enrolled part-time.	\$ 1,485.00
John Morris Roslyn Educational Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses for students in Math or Engineering. Recipient must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Virginia for at least one year. Recipient must demonstrate financial need with preference given to those who have overcome adversity or shown tenacity in bettering themselves as indicated in the personal statement section of the scholarship application. Recipient may be enrolled part-time and must maintain a 3.0 GPA.	\$ 2,000.00
Mabeline Walker Williams & John E. Williams, Sr. Memorial Annual Healthcare Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition for student enrolled in a health professions program of study. Preference will be given to African-American students. Priority will be given to students demonstrating financial need. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA.	\$ 995.00
Martha and William Adams Trust Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition and other mandatory fees to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.	\$ 1,000.00
Michael E. Warner Memorial Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees to a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA enrolled in and pursuing a degree in Nursing or certificate in Practical Nursing. Priority will be given to those students demonstrating financial need and who plan to remain in the College's service region after graduation to practice nursing (i.e., LPN or RN students).	\$4,000.00
Odasz Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses. Priority is given in the following order to workers or former workers of Odasz farms or The Church of Transfiguration. Raymond & Melvin Hubbard Annual	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in the Advanced Technology in Mechatronics program with demonstrated financial need and a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those students who are from Bedford or Roanoke Counties or from Roanoke City zipcode 24013.	\$ 1,060.00
Refugee and Immigrant Scholarship	Provides tuition assistance for students who provide either: proof of entering the U.S. under a refugee status (includes Special Immigrant Visa status); legal documentation of approved asylum status; proof of active Temporary Protected Status; letter from Commonwealth Catholic Charities indicating refugee/asylum status; or Deferred Action for Childhood Arrival documentation. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.	\$ 850.00
Richfield Living Annual Nursing Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees for up to two students enrolled in and in good standing with the Registered Nursing or Licensed Practical Nursing program at Virginia Western. Second Chance Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees to students possessing a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority given to students whose lives have been affected by addiction and/or who wish to promote a safe and drug-free community or those students who have dedicated their lives to helping people find a second chance at life.	\$ 500.00
Sister Eveline Murray Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in a minimum of 15 credits per semester. Students enrolled in 12 to 14 credits per semester qualify for a scholarship reduced by 50%. Priority is given to members of The Church of Transfiguration, or residents of Botetourt County. One of the recommendation letters must be from the donor's designated church representative on church letterhead.	\$ 850.00
Suzanne Hanks Paralegal Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in the Paralegal Studies program. Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to Franklin County schools graduates who have demonstrated financial need.	\$ 800.00
The Charlotte Woolwine Scholarship for Sole Caregivers...	Provides assistance for a student who is sole-support provider parent/individual appointed with legal custody and guardianship of one or more children. Scholarship shall provide assistance for tuition, books, fees, living expenses for recipient pursuing an associate degree in a financial-aid eligible program of study. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.	\$ 2,255.00
Trane Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees for students enrolled in the Air Conditioning and Refrigeration Program. Student must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to Trane - Virginia District employees and their dependents; if none apply, then preference is given to those demonstrating financial need.	\$ 885.00
Virginia Western BIPOC Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in a communications/advertising AAS program of study such as Visual Design, Communication Design, Management or Administrative Management Technology or a Career Studies Certificate in Web Programming or Management Entrepreneurship.
