Scholarship Description/Criteria

Accounting Annual Scholarship for Adult Learners

Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees to a student enrolled in an A.A.S. Accounting program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Academic and personal goals, as well as strength of commitment to an accounting career, shall be detailed in the personal statement section provided on the scholarship application. The applicant must also submit a recommendation from a viable professional resource.

African-American Railroad Heritage Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in a program of study with a cumulative 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to African-American students. Recipients of the scholarship are required to attend an African-American Railroad Heritage Celebration at the Virginia Museum of Transportation in Roanoke Virginia, if scheduled.

Al Pollard Memorial Annual Scholarship for the Culinary Arts

Provides assistance to first-year and continuing students for tuition, books and other related expenses. No minimum GPA is required to apply. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be enrolled in the Culinary Arts associate degree program. Applicants must detail their commitment to the culinary arts profession, commenting on any previous culinary arts experience and their future goals in the field.

Al Pollard Memorial Endowed Scholarship for the Culinary Arts

Provides assistance to first-year and continuing students for tuition, books and other related expenses. No minimum GPA is required to apply. Recipients must maintain a 2.5 GPA and be enrolled in the Culinary Arts associate degree program. Applicants must detail their commitment to the culinary arts profession, commenting on any previous culinary arts experience and their future goals in the field.

Alice Becker Hinchcliffe Williams Dental Hygiene Licensure Scholarship

Provides assistance for the fees associated with the Dental Hygiene National Board Examination and a regional clinical exam. Priority is given to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrated financial need. Recipient must have a letter of recommendation from a Dental Hygiene faculty member and be a member of the Student American Dental Hygiene Association.

Alice Becker Hinchcliffe Williams Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for a first-year and a second-year student enrolled in the Dental Hygiene Program with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need. Students must detail their commitment to the dental hygiene career in the personal statement section on the scholarship application.

Alumni Association Annual Book Scholarship

Provide assistance for books to students who have completed a minimum of 24 credit hours at Virginia Western with a minimum GPA of 2.5. Priority is given to those students who wish to obtain their associate degree from Virginia Western and who demonstrate financial need.

American Sign Language Endowed Scholarship in Memory of Laura Knight Schowe Provides assistance for tuition expenses for students enrolled in a Sign Language course or seminar, with a minimum 3.0 GPA. Applicants must have completed one semester of Sign Language or have previous Sign Language experience.

Appalachian Power Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in the Engineering and Technology Program. Students must maintain part-time enrollment with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to Appalachian Power employees and their dependents; if none apply, then preference is given to those demonstrating financial need.

Archibald Carter (Chip) Magee Memorial Annual Scholarship for Paralegal Studies

Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in a paralegal program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicants must indicate intent to pursue continuing higher education pathways for attainment of enrollment in law school. Priority will be given to students demonstrating financial need. Students may receive consecutive awards without application per continued eligibility.

Barbara McKinney Watts Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition and other related fees to an incoming student. Priority will be given to a student who is enrolled in the Pre-Nursing, LPN or RN Nursing programs.

Barry L. Pendrey Memorial Scholarship

Provides assistance to students enrolled in the Criminal Justice Program, with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Applicants must have completed 24 credit hours and have a letter of recommendation from a Criminal Justice faculty member. Applicants must detail their interest in a career in Criminal Justice in the personal statement section on the scholarship application.

BB&T Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in the Business Science Division with an emphasis in Management. Recipient must maintain full-time enrollment with a minimum 2.5 GPA.

Bent Mountain Center Annual Scholarship

Provide assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in any financial aid-eligible program (academic or credential track). Priority is given to students who demonstrate financial need and are from the Bent Mountain area, as represented by zip code 24059, with a secondary preference for zip codes 24079 (Copper Hill), 24067 (Callaway), 24018 (Roanoke), 24065 (Boones Mill), 24162 (Montgomery County).

Beverly and Leon Harris Occupational/Technical Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA pursuing an Associate of Applied Science degree, certificate or career studies certificate. Priority is given to students demonstrating financial need.

Beverly and Leon Harris Teaching & Nursing Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA who intends to pursue a career in teaching or who is pursuing a degree in Nursing or a certificate in Practical Nursing. Priority is given to students demonstrating financial need.

Beverly Day Williamson, Jr. Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for books and other related expenses to second-year students (with a minimum 24 credits earned). Priority is given to applicants who demonstrate financial need for funds to graduate from Virginia Western with an associate degree.

Bridging the Gap Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition and other mandatory fees to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Preference is given to Black students demonstrating financial need. Recipients are expected to assist in recruiting other students to Virginia Western, contribute to the fund after college, and either participate in the college's Work Study Program or have part-time employment off-campus.

Brooke Ferguson Memorial Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition to a part-time or full-time student enrolled in a financial aid-eligible program of study. Applicants who are first-year students must possess a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA. Applicants in a returning year of study (second year, third- year, or etc.) must possess a minimum 2.5 cumulative GPA.

Brown & Sons Farm Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses for one academic year to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to residents of Franklin County (specifically in Smith Mountain Lake area—Glade Hill, Hardy, Burnt Chimney and Wirtz). Preference is given to first-year students.

Business, Technology & Trades Annual Scholarship in honor of Deborah A. Yancey

Provides assistance for tuition to students enrolled in a Business, Technology & Trades program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA. Priority will be given to those demonstrating financial need.

Commonwealth Legacy Scholarship

Provides a year of tuition and books to a first-year, associate-degree seeking student. Student must agree to promote community college education and the Commonwealth Legacy Scholarship Program, mentor future scholars and demonstrate a commitment to developing leadership potential. Student must have graduated high school with a minimum 3.5 GPA and maintain at least a 3.5 GPA during semesters of award. Selection is based on merit.

Construction Management Certificate Program Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees to applicants who have high school degree or GED, are enrolled in at least two credits per semester in the Construction Management Career Studies Certificate Program and maintain a 2.0 GPA. Recipient must purchase course materials through the Virginia Western Campus Bookstore. Recipients must indicate their intent to work primarily in residential construction in the personal statement section on the scholarship application.

Continental Societies Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for books, tuition and other mandatory fees. Preference is given to Black students demonstrating financial need. Community service involvement and strength of commitment to a chosen career are also considered and should be detailed in the personal statement section on the scholarship application.

Cornerstone Building Brands Annual Scholarship at Virginia Western

Provide assistance for tuition to part- or full-time student(s). Recipient may be awarded in subsequent sequential semesters should eligibility requirements be maintained. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 cumulative GPA. Priority will be given to current Cornerstone Building Brands employees/family members of current Cornerstone Building Brands employees.

David L. Nickerson Honorary Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, fees, and books to students who are enrolled in a Liberal Arts program, and who have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Priority is given to students with demonstrated financial need.

Delta Dental Annual Scholarship for Dental Hygiene

Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees for student(s) enrolled in the Dental Hygiene program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA. Preference will be given to students of underserved communities. Preference will be given to students who agree to a rotation in a safety net facility.

Delta Dental of Virginia Foundation Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees (including national and clinical examination fees) to a student with a minimum 3.5 GPA pursuing an Associate of Applied Science in the Dental Hygiene program. Before applying, applicants must have been accepted into Virginia Western's dental hygiene program.

Dennis L. & Hazel Phillips Blalock Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Provides tuition, books and expenses for one academic year. The recipient(s) of this scholarship may not receive total financial aid in excess of estimated annual living expenses. Applicants must complete the standard financial aid application used at the college. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA.

Developmental Math Scholarship

Provides tuition support for a student currently enrolled in a Virginia Western developmental math course. Student must have a GPA of 2.0 or greater.

Diana D. Good Memorial Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students who are enrolled in the Early Childhood Development Program. Students must have completed 6 credits in the program and have a minimum 2.5 GPA. Students must detail their intention to complete the Early Childhood Development Program in. the personal statement section on the scholarship application. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.

Dolores Martin Skelly Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in an Associate of Science program in Science: Integrated Environmental Studies or in Science: Mathematics. Students must be graduates of Patrick Henry or William Fleming high schools in the city of Roanoke. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.

Down Syndrome Association of Roanoke Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance to students with cognitive disabilities who are enrolled in a curriculum. Priority is given to students with Down Syndrome; if none apply, then preference is given to those with cognitive disabilities, and finally to those with any disability. Applicants must provide a recommendation from a member of the Student Support Services office.

Dr. Betty Turner Shepherd Nursing Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition and other related fees to students entering the second semester of the Nursing Program. Students must be enrolled in one of the 10 credit/semester Nursing courses and maintain a minimum 3.0 grade point average.

Dr. Donna Harpold Memorial Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to second-year students in the Nursing Program who have demonstrated academic potential and professionalism. Preference is given to single caregivers.

Dr. Elizabeth W. Payne Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for books and technical support expenses to a student enrolled in the Business Sciences Division with a concentration in one or more of the following: Accounting, AST, Business Administration, Clerical Studies, Legal Assisting, Management, Medical Transcription, Microcomputer Systems Technology, Office Technology and Office Assistant. Priority is given to students demonstrating financial need.

Dr. George K. Bowers Youth Haven-Sanctuary Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and related expenses to students who demonstrate financial need and who: have finished or attended Youth Haven or Sanctuary; attended counseling with the Roanoke Juvenile Services and are recommended by the Youth Care Administrator; have been recommended by the courts/probation departments of Roanoke City, Roanoke County and Salem; are before the court on petition, or youth who are before Juvenile Intake; are enrolled in the Criminal Justice program.

Dr. J. Andrew Archer Memorial Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in a program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA.

Dr. Kevin Conway Endowed Scholarship	Provide assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in Health Technology Division. Students must have a minimum 2.5 grade point average. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Educational Foundation Textbook Scholarship	Provides textbook payment assistance up to \$500 at the Virginia Western Campus Bookstore. Scholarship funds not used by the recipient in the Campus Bookstore revert back to the Educational Foundation. Applicant must provide a recommendation from at least one Virginia Western instructor or academic advisor on their application. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Elisabeth (Liz) Reed Carter Educational Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in a program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA, and be pursuing degrees or certificates in Horticulture, Environmental Studies, Plant Science or Forestry.
Employee Family Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to a student whose spouse or parent has been employed at Virginia Western for at least two years, August through May. Students must maintain a minimum 2.5 GPA.
Employee Giving Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other expenses to students entering their second year with the desire to complete their associate degree. The applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Farrell Family Endowed Scholarship	Provide assistance for tuition, books and related expenses for students enrolled in the Automotive Analysis & Repair program of study. Applicant must be enrolled in a minimum of 9 credits for the semester, with a minimum 2.5 GPA.
Foot Levelers Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in the Health Technology or Business Division. Priority is given to employees of Foot Levelers and/or their dependents.
Fralin & Waldron, Inc. Endowed Scholarship in Memory of Craig E. Via	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in Engineering: Engineering Construction or MSET: Design Engineering Technology. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Fralin Futures STEM-H Scholarship	Provides tuition assistance and matching life stipends to students who are currently enrolled at Virginia Western in a designated STEM-H program of study each semester; have and maintain a minimum 3.0 GPA and be in good academic and financial standing; be enrolled in their final two semesters during the award cycle. Award is based on merit.
Fred Whitaker Company Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition and books to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to FWC employees and their dependents; if none apply, then preference is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Friendship Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to a student with a minimum 2.5 GPA and demonstrated financial need.
Garnett E. and Patsy T. Smith Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students who have graduated from an accredited Christian or parochial high school.

George T. Wade Memorial Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition to a student in a program of study (excluding libera arts or social sciences) or pursuing an industry-recognized certificate or credential Preference will be given to African-American students. Applicants must have a minimum 2.5 GPA, demonstrate financial need and be employed in the communit
Gerald Pace Textbook Scholarship for Salem CCAP Students	Provides assistance to a Salem CCAP student starting their second year of Salem CCAP. Student must be enrolled in a minimum 9 credits for the semester, have cumulative 3.0 GPA or better, and receive no federal or state financial aid.
Gerry Montgomery Meador Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition and other mandatory fees to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Gertrude Light Hubbard Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in the Nursing Program with demonstrated financial need and a minimun 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to students from Franklin or Roanoke counties or from Roanoke City ZIP code 24013.

Glenna H. Hall Memorial Endowed Scholarship Provides assistance for tuition for a student enrolled part-time in a Business, for Women in Business Trades & Technology program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA. Priority will be given to students demonstrating financial need. established by Edwin C. Hall

Applicant must submit the FAFSA for the applicable year. Recipient must maintain a minimum 2.0 GPA and may be enrolled part-time.

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to a student pursuing a degree or certificate from a program within the School of Business, Technology, and Trades or the School of Science, Technology, Engineering, and Math.

Provides assistance to students enrolled in the Visual Design Program with a minimum 2.75 GPA. The student must detail a commitment to visual design and community service in the personal statement section on the scholarship application. One of the letters of recommendation required for the scholarship application must come from a Virginia Western Visual Design faculty member.

John Morris Roslyn Educational Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses for students in Math or Engineering. Recipient must be a U.S. citizen and a resident of Virginia for at least one year. Recipient must demonstrate financial need with preference given to those who have overcome adversity or shown tenacity in bettering themselves as indicated in the personal statement section of the scholarship application. Recipient may be enrolled part-time and must maintain a 3.0 GPA.

Judy Hackworth Memorial Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses for a guidance counselor, teacher or student studying education-related courses.

Katherine Futrell Memorial Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition and books to students with a minimum 3.5 GPA. Priority is given to a student from the college's School of Health Professions demonstrating financial need.

Kiwanis Club of Botetourt County Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to a student with a minimum 2.0 GPA pursuing a degree or certificate. Applicants must be residents of Botetourt County. Priority is given to students who demonstrate financial need.

Laurens Sartoris Commonwealth Legacy Scholarship

Provide assistance with tuition, books and fees for first or second year students in the Nursing program. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 cumulative GPA, may be enrolled part-time or full-time and must demonstrate financial need.

LewisGale Medical Center Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled with a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to LewisGale Medical Center employees and/or their dependents. Preference is given to those demonstrating financial need.

Linda French Cecil Memorial Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in at least 3 credits per semester/credits dictated by program in a nursing/nursing related program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 3.0 GPA. Preference will be given to students identifying as female and/or first-generation students. Priority will be given to students demonstrating financial need.

Lorraine Pleasants Memorial Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition to a student enrolled in a program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA, and have graduated from either William Fleming or Franklin County high schools. Preference will be given to African-American students demonstrating financial need. Recipients of this scholarship in prior academic years are ineligible.

Lucian Y. and June B. Grove Honorary Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in the Engineering Program. If no Engineering student is eligible, consideration will be given to a student enrolled in an Education-track program. Applicant must have a minimum 3.0 GPA and detail commitment to living and working in the Roanoke Region and Commonwealth of Virginia in the personal statement section of the scholarship application. Priority given to those demonstrating financial need.

Mabeline Walker Williams & John E. Williams, Sr. Memorial Annual Healthcare Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition for student enrolled in a health professions program of study. Preference will be given to African-American students. Priority will be given to students demonstrating financial need. Applicants must possess a minimum 2.0 GPA.
Madeline Brown Dearing & Gertrude Brown Logan Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in the Nursing Program or in the Business Science Division. Students must have a minimum 2.5 GPA and have completed one academic semester at VWCC to receive this scholarship. Preference is given to minority students demonstrating financial need.
McFarland Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students with a minimum 2.5 GPA. To be eligible, students must have completed one prior academic semester. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.
Michael E. Warner Memorial Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and fees to a student with a minimum 3.0 GPA enrolled in and pursing a degree in Nursing or certificate in Practical Nursing. Priority will be given to those students demonstrating financial need and who plan to remain in the College's service region after graduation to practice nursing (i.e., LPN or RN students).
Michael Smith Commonwealth Legacy Scholarship	Provide assistance with tuition, books and fees for students enrolled in an accredited program at Virginia Western. Applicant may be enrolled part-time or full-time.
Mike Bassett Memorial Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition and other mandatory expenses to students enrolled in Criminal Justice, Nursing or other Human Services programs. Students must have a minimum 3.0 GPA. Priority is given to graduates of Franklin County High School.
Mr. & Mrs. Emanuel Payne Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition and other mandatory fees to students with a minimum 2.0 GPA. Preference is given to Black students demonstrating financial need. Recipients are expected to participate in the College's Work Study Program or have part-time employment off-campus.
Nicholas E. Janney Memorial Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses for students in the Automotive Technology Program or the Engineering Program, with a preference given to students in the Automotive Technology Program. Students must have a minimum 2.0 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need, with a preference for recent graduates from Botetourt County.
Nursing Endowed Scholarship	Provides assistance to second-year nursing students. Must have a minimum 3.2 GPA. Selection based on academic achievement and financial need.
Odasz Annual Scholarship	Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses. Priority is given in the following order to workers or former workers of Odasz farms or The Church of Transfiguration. Preference will be given to former recipients; then to incoming freshmen, and finally to returning students.

Orrin Clifton Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses for students who

are enrolled in the Dental Hygiene program. The recipient must have a minimum

2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.

Pearman Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to second-year students enrolled in the Visual Design Program. Applicant must submit 4 examples of work from ART-141 Typography course and 4 examples of work from ART-140 Intro to Computer Graphics course.

Peter and Roseta Skelly Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees to students enrolled in Health Technology Division. Students must be graduates of Patrick Henry or William Fleming high schools in the city of Roanoke. Priority is given to those demonstrating financial need.

Petroleum Marketers, Inc. Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related fees. Priority will be given to Petroleum Marketers, Inc. employees and their dependents. If none apply, priority is given to those demonstrating financial need. Preference will be given to those students enrolled in the Nursing Program.

Provides tuition assistance students enrolled in an Engineering/Technical program of study. Applicants must possess a minimum 3.0 GPA and be registered in an Engineering/Technical program. Preference will be given to minority students and those students who demonstrate financial need

Raymond and Melvin Hubbard Annual Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in the Advanced Technology in Mechatronics program with demonstrated financial need and a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those students who are from Bedford or Roanoke Counties or from Roanoke City zipcode 24013.

Raymond and Melvin Hubbard Endowed Scholarship

Provides assistance for tuition, books and other related expenses to students enrolled in the Advanced Technology in Mechatronics program with demonstrated financial need and a minimum 2.5 GPA. Priority is given to those students who are from Bedford or Roanoke Counties or from Roanoke City zipcode 24013.

Refugee and Immigrant Scholarship
