



If you are interested in applying to the Occupational Therapy Assistant program at VWCC, you **MUST** complete the VWCC college application, as well as the program application form (other required material is discussed on the “Apply Now” page). The college application can be submitted on-line. The program application must be mailed, attached to email via pdf to [healthprofessions@virginiawestern.edu](mailto:healthprofessions@virginiawestern.edu) or [pwoody@virginiawestern.edu](mailto:pwoody@virginiawestern.edu) or brought to the advisor in the Fralin Center for Science and Health Professions-Room 339 (all material required by February 15<sup>th</sup>).

You are encouraged to complete the VWCC college application on-line by logging into the system at <https://apply.vccs.edu>



Indicate Virginia Western Community College as the college you plan to attend and your plan of study as **Career Studies Certificate: Introduction to Occupational Therapy Assistant or Introduction to Occupational Therapy Assistant-Pediatrics**. Choose the earliest semester or term you may be likely to register for any class at VWCC or no later than summer 2026. High school seniors should select the fall semester (2026). If upon completion of HS you wish to take a summer course and encounter problems registering, you should seek assistance from the college enrollment center in Chapman Hall. If any applicant encounters difficulty submitting your information electronically, further assistance may be available in Chapman Hall for students.
