Applicants must meet the general admission requirements for the college. Students must have completed the following **four (4)** college level **prerequisites** with a "C" or better in each course: **(1) Bio 141** (Human Anatomy & Physiology I-4 cr with a lab-within five years prior), **(2) SDV 101** (Introduction to Health Professions-2 cr.), **(3) ENG 111** (English Composition I-3 cr) and **(4) PSY 230** (Developmental Psychology- 3 cr) are all college **prerequisites**. Enrollment and completion of all **prerequisite(s) must be completed by the end of the spring prior to the fall semester when you are entering/starting the program (spring 2025 for fall 2025)**. Cumulative college **GPA must be 2.50** or higher by the end of Fall 2024 to be eligible (based on at least 12 credit hours) or High School GPA will be used if applicant does not have 12 credit hours of college credit to establish the GPA. Please note: At VWCC the prerequisite for enrollment in BIO 141 is either challenge placement into BIO 141 or completion within the last three (3) years of BIO 101 with a grade of "C" or higher or NAS 2 with a grade of "S". At VWCC the prerequisite for BIO 101/ NAS 2 is ENG 111 placement and successful completion of MDE 10, within the last five years or direct enrollment into college level math course.

The associate-degree-level occupational therapy assistant program will apply for accreditation by the Accreditation Council for Occupational Therapy Education (ACOTE) of the American Occupational Therapy Association (AOTA), located at 6116 Executive Boulevard, Suite 200, North Bethesda, MD 20852-4929 by **12/16/2024**. The first class of OTA students will begin Fall 2025. ACOTE's telephone number c/o AOTA is (301) 652-AOTA and its web address is www.acoteonline.org.

The program must be granted Candidacy Status, have a preaccreditation review, complete an on-site evaluation, and be granted Accreditation Status before its graduates will be eligible to sit for the national certification examination for the occupational therapy assistant administered by the National Board for Certification in Occupational Therapy (NBCOT). After successful completion of this exam, the individual will be a Certified Occupational Therapy Assistant (COTA).

In addition, all states require licensure in order to practice; however, state licenses are usually based on the results of the NBCOT Certification Examination. Note that a felony conviction may affect a graduate's ability to sit for the NBCOT certification examination or attain state licensure
