

If you are interested in applying to the VWCC Practical Nursing program, you MUST complete the college application to VWCC as well as the program application form (other required material is discussed on the "Apply Now" page). The college application can be submitted on-line. The program application must be mailed or submitted to the HP Advising & Applications Office in the Fralin Center - Rm. 339 (all application material is required (or postmarked to the college) by September 1 for Spring consideration and April 1 for Fall consideration).

Indicate Virginia Western Community College as the institution you plan to attend **and your plan of study as Career Studies Certificate: Introduction to Practical Nursing**. Choose the earliest semester you may be likely to register for any class at VWCC. High school seniors should select the fall semester following HS graduation; if upon completion of HS you wish to take a summer course and encounter problems registering, you should seek assistance from the college enrollment center staff.
