## MOTORCYCLE SAFETY RIDER COURSES

### BASIC RIDER COURSE

The Basic Rider Course (BRC) is a complete entry-level, learn to ride class. This class consists of online classroom instruction as well as in-person motorcycle operation and instruction. Upon successful completion of the course, students are provided a Virginia license waiver to be taken to the DMV for endorsement purposes. This program is physically demanding, and students should be in good physical condition and have a good sense of balance.

Students must have a valid driver's license or learner's permit, sturdy shoes high enough to cover the ankle, full fingered gloves, long pants without holes in the legs, and eye protection. Motorcycles (none larger than 500 cc) are provided for this program. Students must provide their own helmet. **Students under 18 years of age must have parent signature on waiver forms.**

**This course is not eligible for financial aid and CANNOT be audited.**

#### Class Cost and Times

**CLASSROOM PORTION:                    ONLINE (a class link will be sent to student)**

Students must complete, on their own, an online portion to participate in the program and will be emailed a link approximately two weeks before class. Once complete, you are required to bring the completion certificate to the instructor the first day of class. If you do not have the certificate, you will be dropped from the program and ineligible for a refund.

Students will meet Saturday morning in room M245 of the Business Science Building, 2<sup>nd</sup> floor.

**Students MUST be on time for both class meetings. NO ADMITTANCE for late arrivals. Late arrivals will be dismissed without a refund.**

#### Attendance and Tuition Policy

Students who register for the class but do not attend, will be charged for the course, unless they withdraw **PRIOR** to the class dates. Students dropping the course **PRIOR** to the first class will receive a refund and not be charged.

Students who are removed from the course for safety issues, **will not receive a refund**. Instructors have final say on whether a student is removed from the course due to safety or other issues.

Any classes cancelled for weather or other factors, will be rescheduled as soon as possible. Students who cannot attend the rescheduled dates, will be placed in another section of the course if available or refunded.
